February 2022 GRC Meeting Minutes

GSA 2022-2023 General and Health & Dental Fees for Approval (Mary Zhang) 17h36

- We expect these few years of increase to steady out soon
- Health and Dental Plan Fees Proposal
 - o Individual plan: increase by 8% (estimated 15% increase in plan premium)
 - difference subsidized by Reserve funds: ~\$110k (\$306k if virtual healthcare services continues)
 - o Additional 1 dependent: increase 8% (like the individual plan)
 - Additional ≥ 2 dependents: gradually phased increase to bring more in line with actual cost and in line with individual cost (this is 2x individual fee)
 - will additionally increase 8% (to remain in line with individual fee)

- Motion 1: To approve the following: No change to the GSA General fee amount for the 2022-2023 year AND Motion 2: To approve the following: Increase the Health and Dental Plan (H&D) student fee from \$579 to \$626; increase the H&D fee for one dependent from \$579 to \$626; and increase the H&D fee for 2 or more dependents from \$1,035 to \$1,252
 - Moved: Mary Zhang
 - Seconded: Jasper Greysson-Wong
 - Discussion:
 - Question: Why do we use a third-party admin (Studentcare)?
 - Answer: We don't have the resources to do it by ourselves, and they can get a better deal than we can get.
 - Question: Can we expect that this fee stays the same for the next years? (as it did prior to covid)?
 - Answer: No. Inflation, and added benefits mean it will go up.
 - Question: What is the economic reasoning behind increasing these fees?
 - Answer: There was a built-up artificially low cost caused by two years of no increase.
 - Question: A family increase of \$217 seems a bit steep...is there a way it could be slightly subsidized again this year, then "catch up" to the other fees next year?
 - Answer: Right now, they are paying less than 2x the cost of individual plan, so are already very low compared to the other plans.
 - Question: What extra services are we getting for an increase fee?
 - Answer: Includes the EmpowerMe services (we were not charged for the first year).
 - Question: I am wondering how do these fees compare to fees and services at other Universities?
 - Answer: Email Mary and you can get the comparison. However, it is difficult to compare because different schools provide different services, etc.
 - Question: How many families are enrolled in the plan compared to individuals/couples? (e.g., how much would it cost to subsidize families compared to the subsidy in place for individuals?)
 - Answer: Don't have the numbers now, but can get them for you.

- Question: If the motion is opposed, would we be able to fight for a lower increase or would it be a higher increase if we do not agree to these numbers?
 - Answer: The 15% is the estimated increase that will occur to the premium. Students will pay only 8% in their Plan Fee. The GSA is subsidizing some of that (using the Reserve), so that the increase can be "spread over" a few years.
- Question: Do you have the information to clarify the number of years we can expect to see these increases?
 - Answer: We don't have the information
- Question: Not directly related to current increases, but is there any intention to review the plan/insurance provider in the future?
 - We currently have a five-year agreement with Studentcare
- Question: How long can the GSA continue to subsidize fee increases? Relatedly, how is this funded - is it sustainable?
 - Answer: We are figuring that out, and expect the fees to plateau in a few years.

2022-2023 GSA/LDL draft budgets (Mary Zhang) 18h09

- Draft GSA budgets will be sent out to GRC representative for review Feb. 23, 2022
- GSA Restricted Budgets
 - Collective Agreement Budget
 - Revenue source: 0.5% payroll deduction from academically employed graduate students
 - Major expenses include: LRC honorariums, Service agreement fees to PSAC, GSA staff support
 - Advocacy Budget
 - Revenue source: \$9 Advocacy Levy paid by graduate students
 - Major expenses include: CASA & ab-GPAC membership dues, Advocacy meetings, conference expenses
 - Professional Development Grant Budget
 - Revenue source: \$5 PDG Levy paid by graduate students
 - Quality Money Budget
 - Revenue source: allocated from University of Calgary
 - Increased grad student groups support funding, admin staff support allocation, reallocation of GSA citizenship awards and awards website to GSA operating budget
 - Health & Dental Budget
 - Revenue source: Health & Dental fees paid by grad students
 - Budget reflects a 15% increase in Studentcare premiums and an 8% increase in Health & Dental Fees
- GSA Operating and LDL Budgets
 - Operating Budget
 - Major revenue source: membership fees paid by grad students
 - Expenses include: GSA Bursary Top-up, reallocation of GSA citizenship award and awards website to GSA operating budget, increased LDL loss due to reopening costs since March 2020 closure
 - Last Defence Lounge Budget
 - Sales estimate is 50% of last operating year (2019-2020)

Question period (Speaker) 18h36

- Question: What are the chances that covid safety measures will actually be reviewed before the term ends?
 - Answer: (Kirsten) The U of C is keeping all safety protocols announced in January (e.g., masking, social distancing) until end of winter term. We are in consultation right now, looking at where things will go.
 - (Tanille) The Minister of Higher Education gave a directive to U of C, but most students don't want it (see survey mentioned above). We want physical and mental safety to be taken care of.
 - (Alex) At the end of the term, all safety protocols will be reviewed. Reminder: If you are having any issues as a TA, go to the LRC (they are there to help you.)
- Question: When can we expect LDL to reopen?
 - Answer: (Mary) Early April, likely.
- Question: I heard that the Minister of Advanced Education of Alberta is advocating for all
 post-secondary institutions to align their COVID-19 policies with that of the Alberta
 province (i.e., removing everything by March 1st). Is there any likelihood that the
 University will go along with that and remove safety measures like masking before the
 term is over?
 - o Answer: (Kirsten) No, not until the end of semester.
- Question: How will social distancing be effective in a small and full classroom?
 - Answer: (Tanille) Not sure all social distancing will be fulfilled, because of room sizes.
- Question: When will we learn about the results of the GRC poll about potentially keeping these meetings online?
 - Answer: (Crystal) Any changes will be communicated once the board has reviewed the results.
