communicated to university students year over year by April 30,

2023.

Goal: Consult with graduate beyond the GSA 2024/26

Strategic Plan.

Explanation: We are close to producing a draft a new three-year

plan, 2023-2026. It will provide a roadmap to our organization for the next three years. However, we know the needs of graduate students will continue to evolve and change. To ensure that our advocacy strategies align with these changing needs, we will continue to consult with fellow graduate students

regularly.

Updates: The GSA advocacy survey is still open. Be encouraged

> to share your thoughts by completing the survey. This will better inform our advocacy priorities and strategies to the municipal, provincial, and federal governments. For example, internally, we have heard from several fellow graduate students on the need to improve services at the wellness centre. We have acted on such concerns and there is good news. The Wellness Centre have hired additional student-advisors for the success centre, residence, and a tenured position for an indigenous advisor (to follow soon). These are the sorts of impacts consultation can have. Also, we have spent a few weeks discussing proposed tuition and fees increases for the 2023/24 academic year. discussed with the institution for future consultations when discussing important topics, such as tuition, with the graduate student body and Graduate

Representative Council.

Doing so ensures that students are adequately consulted by the university on all critical decisions and have incorporated feedback from students into the final decisions. We will continue to work with the Students' Union and Provost office to develop these key stakeholder consultation guidelines for the mutual benefit of

Improving Communication

and fully engage in its governance. One of the gaps we heard from fellow students is the lack DGA involvement. My team intends to lay the foundation for reengaging our

DGAs.

This report is to be shared with all graduate students to keep students informed about the

to the GRC in January.



Strategic Plan Goals

As VP Academic, I am committed to ensure that all aspects of my portfolio are in alignment with the GSA's Strategic Plan. The GSA's 3-year strategic plan 2019-2022 can be found here.

Advocacy

Graduate Student Vacation

- Advocating for graduate student vacation to be increased from a suggested minimum of 2 weeks to protected minimum of 3 weeks (ongoing).
 - We have compared comparative research with various comparable institutions along with the health benefits of increased vacation and the potential benefits for productivity of graduate students.
 - Now that the research is compiled, Dr. Mary Grantham O'Brien and myself, Senior Associate Dean FGS, will present the research to the appropriate University committees to get this approved.

Student Supervisor Best Practices

- Another collaboration with FGS to compile an extensive set of best practices supervisors and their students.
 - For now, the goal of this project is simply to create a reference for best practice, though with the expectation that the research will reveal policies that must be updated. I will advocate for these changes as needed, should the changes be a priority for graduate students.
 - Along with Clifton Cunningham, Associate Dean FGS, we are going the data of students who were required to withdraw, to understand what can be done to avoid these extreme cases and work our way back from there.

Needs Based Funding & TFCC

- There has been a doubling of requests for Needs Based Funding since last year, which itself was a record year for such requests.
 - This was one of our 'asks' for TFCC consultation, to have needs-based funding tied to the Consumer Price Index, along with an extraordinary increase for this year given that Needs Based Funding has not been increased in over 3 years.
 - o We are expecting a decision on this in early December.



Currently, I am exploring other avenues to advocate for students towards this
end.

Other Asks in TFCC

- Saaka and I submitted our proposed rebuttal to the Tuition and Fee increases.
 - Aside from the aforementioned increase for needs-based funding, we requested that the increase for international students be closer to CPI, whereas now it greatly exceeds it.
 - We also advocated for increased funding to the Wellness Centre and to mental health supports.
 - As mentioned above, we hope to see the needle moved in the direction of our asks, with more information coming early December.

Personal Advocacy

- Throughout the year, I advocate for individual students and help guide them through any
 academic difficulties they might be encountering. This can include trouble with a
 supervisor or an instructor but can take many shapes.
- If you or someone you know requires assistance related to such matters, please feel free
 to contact me; no problem is too small, and I meet with multiple students each week.

Committees

I sit as the graduate student representative on various committees. If you have concerns
that you want heard, please let me know and I will be sure to voice them at the
appropriate meeting.

Events Updates

PEER Beyond 2023

- Working with the help of our capable events coordinator Jaime and communications manager Thao, PEER Beyond 2023 is starting to take shape!
- The graduate research conference will take place during February 11th and 12th at the Taylor Institute for Teaching and Learning.
- Visit our website to register now! You will have the opportunity to present a talk, poster, or performance piece relevant to your research.
- This year, we also have a contest for graphic design and slogan design for the conference! The winners will be chosen by a poll open to all graduate students. We cannot wait to see what you all come up with!
- We will also be collaborating with FGS to have the awards ceremony for Images of Research during Peer Beyond.
- The Academic Support Committee will host several Professional Development workshops to prepare students for PEER Beyond.



Mitacs Workshops

- In collaboration with Annie from Mitacs, I put on a pair of workshops in the last week of October and the first week of November.
- The first workshop explained the process of applying for a Mitacs internship, while the second focused on finding an Industry partner to sponsor the internship.
- Both events were well attended, with approx. 50 people attending between in-person and online.
- We hope to collaborate with Annie and her team in future projects.

Improving Organization Sustainability

GSA Governance vs Operations Policy and Procedure Review

- Along with Saaka, Lina, Daniella, and Andrew, each week we meet to go over the various policies and procedures in the GSA.
- The eventual goal is to streamline our policies and procedures and to safeguard the GSA against some of the difficulties the organization has faced in the last year.



- Have submitted updates to:
 - F.06 Grants for Graduate Students
 - I.04 Intellectual Property
- o Drafted an update for F.02 Student Loans, but the Feds passed this already.
- o Still to come:
 - New Policy: Food-Security
 - New Policy: Affordable Housing
- Andrew and I are helping draft a policy paper on food-housing insecurity.

Graduate Advisory Committee (GAC)

o F.06 done. Mainly developing and framing our Asks for Advo Week.

ab-GPAC Membership

- Met with our fellow members (Oct 21st, Nov 18th) to review our workplans.
- Working groups still haven't met. I lead the food-housing group and sit on PSE affordability; our 3rd Director, Kirsten, leads the mental health working group.
 - Moved our Advo Week to January 16th-19th. Passed motion to take the following asks:
 - o Restored public funding to PSIs, and mitigate the privatization of PSE.
 - o Better Mental Health Support for students
 - More financial aid for graduate students (grants, bursaries)
 - o Immigration paths and the ANIP.
- We are still evaluating our position as a paid member. Stay tuned.

Calgary Student Alliance Membership



- I sit on Transit Reform Committee we asked to enroll students in the low-income transit pass, and were returned an option to create two streams of UPass: a standard- and lowincome pass.
- Have asked Shane (Ancillary Services) to see our UPass contract. Awaiting reply.
- Ongoing discussion of transit safety: emphasizing that we need to address the roots of these issues: investing in harm reduction, rather than increasing police presence.

Advocacy: Local and On-Campus Initiatives

Food-Security Huddles with the Students' Union and Provost's Office

- Taking survey of the food-access programs and opportunities on campus.
- Change of Provost means we've had to ensure the conversation remains (promising).
- Provost's office in collaboration with many others on campus have launched the
 Nourish to Flourish Working Group, thanks to the help of an anonymous donor, to
 facilitate programs of immediate food access on campus: two community fridges and a
 meal-voucher pilot coming soon!
- Nourish to Flourish had its first meeting, Nov. 15th. Understands that our focus should aim towards sustainable operations and eliminating the roots of food insecurity in the long-run, but needs to develop some band-aid solutions for the time being.

Food-Housing (ad-hoc) Working Group

- Finished the groups Terms of Reference and Offered Pam Farrell the position of Chair.
- Our purpose is to understand the roots of food-housing (in)security for our campus members; collaborate with Nourish to Flourish to improve security for our community.
- Secondly to explore opportunities for housing/food-access and/or literacy partnerships in the city, and to expand the <u>GSA's Food-Housing Website</u> with further info.

Advocacy Engagement Working Group

- Founded to improve students' access and engagement to the advocacy efforts.
- Shifting focus: spaces to train our DGAs in knowing their power as organizations.
- Have set about three types of roles for the group membership: Events/Logistics;
 Outreach/Onboarding; Research/Messaging.
- Looking for more members!

Collaborative Opportunity – FASA.

 FASA have had to reboot their exec team since their president became VP External for the SU. Haven't heard much from them since.

Collaborative Opportunity – CAUS.

- CAUS is creating a voter-pledge-mobilizing campaign, would like our help.
- They have reached out through abGPAC to collaborate on this campaign.

Collaborative Opportunity – Public Service Alliance of Candada (PSAC), Public Interest Alberta (PIA), and Alberta Federation of Labour (AFL)

- These organizations are in solidarity with post-secondary education, and open to collaborating on some public campaigns leading up to the next election.
- · Opportunity for training sessions, "how-to-organize" for interested students.

*How to move the GSA as an Organization

- As an organization, our definitions, protocols, and procedures are given in our Bylaws.
- The GSA is made of "active membership", meaning all graduate students currently
 enrolled at UCalgary. Every active member is automatically a member of their respective
 departmental graduate association/consortium. Each department elects their
 representative to correspond with the executive Board through the GRC.

Graduate Representative Council (GRC)

- The GRC has authority over priorities and focal points of the Board.
- · GRC generally follows Roberts Rules of Order.
- The Board must abide by motions tabled and passed at GRC meetings. If there is something you would like the Board to do, you need to table and pass a motion at GRC.

As a departmental graduate association (DGA) or consortium

- Your departmental association/consortium is governed by your internal constitution/bylaws. Ask your DGA exec where you can find these posted.
- Your DGA is free to endorse/act in solidarity

As an individual or self-assembled collective

You are free to act so long as you remain in the <u>University's Policies and Procedures</u>.



Improving Advocacy

Meeting with Kaitlin Van Geel, Counsellor, Wellness Centre, Oct 31, 2022

- I have informed them about different student struggles:
 - Financial anxieties and possible workshops or sessions to help students navigate these issues
 - Iranian students facing trauma due to uprising and government crackdown in Iran and possible support sessions.

Meeting with Kevin Wiens, Senior Director, Wellness Centre, Nov 8, 2022

- GSA VPFS, advocacy advisor, and I had a talk with Kevin Wiens about the following topics:
 - The number of students at UCalgary has increased after Covid-19 and getting back to inperson mode, but the number of existing physicians at wellness center has decreased. The wellness center is working on recruiting more physicians.
 - The students are reaching out for more mental health support from wellness centre. The
 wellness centre is interested in recruiting more counsellors and acquiring financial supports
 will help them speed up this process.
 - The need of having an on-call physician was discussed as the students might need emergency assistant at wellness centre.

Advocacy engagement Monthly meeting, Nov 8, 2022


