Improving Advocacy

Objective: Have 30% of the GSA advocacy be informed by consultation and

communicated to university students year over year by April 30,

2023.

Goal: Consult with graduate beyond the GSA 2023/26

Strategic Plan.

Explanation: Our new three-year plan, 2023-2026, is ready. It will

provide a roadmap to our organization for the next three years. However, we know the needs of graduate

students will continue to evolve and change. To ensure that our advocacy strategies align with these changing needs, we will continue to consult with

fellow graduate students regularly.

Updates: The GSA advocacy survey is still open. Be encouraged

to share your thoughts by completing the survey. This will better inform our 2023 advocacy priorities and strategies to the municipal, provincial, and federal governments. There will be more update when we

discuss TFCC.

Objective: Achieve 70% of GSA Annual Survey respondents rate their

satisfaction of the GSA Advocacy work as moderately satisfied or

higher.

Goal: Develop a Consultation guideline for

institutional consultation with graduate

students about important topics

Explanation: As we experienced last Fall, consultation can be

performative. As a result, we are continuing with a project my predecessor was working on with the Students' Union. The expectation is to develop clear guidelines for the institution on future consultations when discussing important topics, such as tuition and



fees proposals, with the graduate student body and

Graduate Representative Council.

Again, the recent tuition and fees hikes is yet another

reason why there is the need to develop the

consultation guidelines into a university policy. It was evident throughout the process that the Provost team

did not listen to the concerns we raised at the November GRC. At the January 11 Finance and Properties Committee meeting, the Provost

committed to working with the GSA and the SU to produce acceptable guidelines for consulting with students. It is critically important that students are adequately consulted by the university and feedback from students incorporated in arriving at key

decisions that directly impact us.

Improving Communication

Updates:

Objective: Increase the GSA Annual Survey response rate to 20% of all enrolled

graduate students.

Goal: Decentralize consultation and improve relationship

with fellow graduate students at the department

level.

Explanation: We want fellow graduate students to take ownership of the

GSA and fully engage in its governance. One of the gaps we heard from fellow students is the lack DGA involvement. My team intends to lay the foundation for reengaging our

DGAs.

Updates: November GRC was very inspiring. Thank you all for

showing up and for expressing your concerns about the proposed tuition and fees increases. In addition, we have increased the DGA events grant. However, your DGAs are not using the funds. Please take full advantage of this pilot program to organize events to improve engagement in your

DGA.

Objective: Have 99% of GSA Annual Survey respondents indicate general

awareness of the GSA and its services.

Goal: Develop a GRC Digest (newsletter) for GRC

members to easily communicate the GRC topics

with their departments.



Explanation:

Enhancing communication between the board and the graduate student body benefits how we work with our partners to across the University of Calgary campuses to improve the graduate student experience. This will be achieved through strategies that will make it easier for GRC representatives to share the information that was discussed at GRC meetings.

Updates:

The GRC is the mouthpiece of fellow graduate students. The GRC digest attempts to eliminate barriers GRC members face in bring forward concerns and a s well as passing the information along to the fellow students in their department. 
Improving Organization Sustainability

Objective:

Included in your meeting package is a draft of the GSA 2022 -2026 Strategic Plan, which requires GRC's approval today. Together with Sherry Choma, our expert consultant, I will present the draft to GRC. I would like to thank my team, Abhishek Thakkar, Sandra Moses, Nneka JK-Onyeka (Governace Committee Vice Chair), Benedicta Antepim (EDI Committee chair), Thao (Communications Manager), Lina (HR Manager), Matt (LDL General manager), Keira (AVP Labor), Andrew (Advocacy Advisor), and Brett (GRC Speaker) for their meaningful participation and contribution. You all brought diverse and insightful perspectives that have shaped the strategic plan we have before GRC today. A second update on organizational sustainability is that we have reviewed the key governing documents of the GSA to streamline governance and operational procedures of the GSA. The changes will be presented to you next month for consideration and approval.

Goal: Explanation:

Develop New GSA Strategic Plan (2023-2026)
Several months earlier, we hired a consultant and assembled a Working Group to develop a new strategic plan. The Working Group concluded our work in December 2022 and I am happy to report that the GSA 2019-2022 Strategic Plan is fully drafted.





Updates:

As noted above, the group did an excellent done job in producing the GSA 2020-2026 Strategic Plan which I shall present to you today.


Additional updates

- Faculty of Graduate Studies Council Executive (FGSC Executive) has received, reviewed, and recommended the following proposals:
 - Termination of MSc in Educational Research and Additional Required Course in PhD in Educational Research in Adult Learning.
 - Restructuring of Master of Strategic Studies and PhD in Strategic Studies.
 - Change in course requirements in the MSc and PhD in Psychology.
- The GSA Support and Emergency Bursaries
 - 2022-2023: Emergency Funding (278 applications, 43 approved and awarded \$40,792).
 - GSA Support Bursary (they received 1168 applications and 634 were approved and awarded \$537,160). We now have \$98,124.6 left for the rest of the academic year.
- o Quality Money (QM)
 - We received 43 applications in two intake periods for Quality Money (QM) and have approved funding for 28 projects in a combined amount of \$107, 617.99. We have seen an increase in QM applications compared to previous years.
- Winter GradO
 - Nearly 200 graduate students attended the Winter GradO, which is relatively smaller in comparison to the Fall GradO. The main takeaway for me was that the sessions were shorter, semiformal, and interactive. I want to acknowledge and appreciate the collaborative work by our staff, Jaime, Thao, Daniella, Matt and the LDL team, and the FGS team. It was a huge success.

Strategic Plan Goals

As VP Academic, I am committed to ensure that all aspects of my portfolio are in alignment with the GSA's Strategic Plan. The GSA's 3-year strategic plan 2019-2022 can be found here.

Advocacy

Graduate Student Vacation

- Advocating for graduate student vacation to be increased from a suggested minimum of 2 weeks to protected minimum of 3 weeks (ongoing).
 - We have compared comparative research with various comparable institutions along with the health benefits of increased vacation and the potential benefits for productivity of graduate students.
 - Now that the research is compiled, Dr. Mary Grantham O'Brien and myself, Senior Associate Dean FGS.
 - Update: Dr. O'Brien and myself presented our case at various committees in the last two months, most importantly presenting it at FGS Council in January. While there are a few more checks and balances this proposal must pass, its passage through FGS Council means that it now has the endorsement of FGS and makes its passage through the remaining university channels all but assured.
 - o It's passage was conditional on a few small amendments: That we add language to make it clear that graduate students must still complete course work if they go on vacation and that we clarify that vacation means time-off (e.g., so that graduate students may take time off even if they do not leave the city).

Student Supervisor Best Practices

- Another collaboration with FGS to compile an extensive set of best practices supervisors and their students.
 - For now, the goal of this project is simply to create a reference for best practice, though with the expectation that the research will reveal policies that must be updated. I will advocate for these changes as needed, should the changes be a priority for graduate students.
 - Along with Clifton Cunningham, Associate Dean FGS, we are going the data of students who were required to withdraw, to understand what can be done to avoid these extreme cases and work our way back from there.
 - Update: No new progress on this progress as we focused on TFCC and the vacation proposal.



TFCC Update

- Throughout November and December, myself, Saaka, and AC went back and forth with the Interim Provost and her team regarding their tuition and fund increase proposal.
- Our goal was primarily to increase needs-based-funding that is provided to the GSA for disbursement, by the university.
- This goal was successful: we were able to increase the quantity of needs-based funding by over \$100,000, or over 20%, as well as an assurance from the university that this funding we'll increase in all subsequent years with the same percentage increase as tuition.
- The University of Calgary has also agreed to a comparable increase in the International Graduate Tuition Award, along with analogous incremental increases according to the increase in tuition.
- We also received assurances from the provost's team that there will be a working group formed to assess student mental on-campus and what the university can do for graduate student mental-health, in particular with respect to the Wellness Centre.
- This was a joint ask with the SU, as they are likewise concerned about the mental well being of their members.
- The result of this as is this working group. The result is not ideal as it does provide any immediate, concrete results. Instead it will be our job as executive to ensure that this working group produces positive results.

Personal Advocacy

- Throughout the year, I advocate for individual students and help guide them through any
 academic difficulties they might be encountering. This can include trouble with a
 supervisor or an instructor but can take many shapes.
- If you or someone you know requires assistance related to such matters, please feel free to contact me; no problem is too small, and I meet with multiple students each week.

appropriate meeting.


Academic Support Committee

GSA Governance vs Operations Policy and Procedure Review

- Along with Saaka, Lina, Daniella, and Andrew, each week we meet to go over the various policies and procedures in the GSA.
- The eventual goal is to streamline our policies and procedures and to safeguard the GSA against some of the difficulties the organization has faced in the last year.
- Update: We have now finished reviewing the documents and are in the process of compiling the results into a new set of policies and procedures. Once these documents have been completed we will then send them distribute them to all GRC members for your review and approval.

Awards

Awards Update

- The Fall 2022 intake of the Bursary, Professional Development Grant have all been completed with the awards disbursed.
- The Winter 2023 intake for the Bursary has now closed and has moved into the evaluation process.
- The Bursary now has an increase in demand of over 300%. We are actively working with various university partners to address some of the underlying problems we have identified so far, and will have more information in this regard soon.
- The increased needs-based funding we received through the FCC consultation will likewise be used to increase payments related to the Bursary, the GSA Bursary and the Emergency Support Bursary.
- I would encourage everyone who is feeling the financial strains, common to the the current graduate student experience, to likewise apply for the University's Tuition Reinvestment Bursary.



 - o More financial aid for graduate students (grants, bursaries)
 - o Immigration paths and the ANIP.
- Board meeting, Dec 16th; asks all in draft. Given a Jan 4th deadline to submit research for Jan 16th advo week. Schedule came out the week of the 9th. There were only two meetings: Ministry of Advanced Ed; Education Critic. I could make neither for conflicting schedules. Kirsten and Saaka represented our organization well. There was little to no training from abGPAC staff, or coordination from the other member associations.
- Overall, we are having difficulties with the other member associations. We do not feel our voices are heard or valued by the other delegates. Meetings are poorly scheduled, and most of our documents appear very last minute.
- We are not happy with our membership here and are drafting a letter of concern.

Advocacy: Local and On-Campus Initiatives

Food-Security Huddles with the Students' Union and Provost's Office

- Nourish to Flourish Working Group, launched a meal voucher program in December, offering vouchers for free meals at the landing, from many campus hubs, 250 vouchers purchased, and all distributed within first 24 hours.
- Nourish to Flourish re-evaluating tactics, looking at what goals are possible in the next year; what are our dreams for food security systems in five years.

Food-Housing (ad-hoc) Working Group

- Pam Farrell has taken the chair position. (Congratulations!)
- We are working on a food-housing assessment survey; made contact with department of sociology who have been developing a food security survey of their own. Collaborating to incorporate aspects of housing situation, travel time, and local food-access to better inform our efforts and advocacy going forward.
- Reached out to the founders of the Grad Snacks program (Foothills Campus) to share resources and food literacy practices.
- Still open to members to help improve housing/food-access and/or literacy partnerships in the city, and to expand the <u>GSA's Food-Housing Website</u> with further info.

- As an organization, our definitions, protocols, and procedures are given in our Bylaws.
- The GSA is made of "active membership", meaning all graduate students currently
 enrolled at UCalgary. Every active member is automatically a member of their respective
 departmental graduate association/consortium. Each department elects their
 representative to correspond with the executive Board through the GRC.

Graduate Representative Council (GRC)

- The GRC has authority over priorities and focal points of the Board.
- GRC generally follows Roberts Rules of Order.
- The Board must abide by motions tabled and passed at GRC meetings. If there is something you would like the Board to do, you need to table and pass a motion at GRC.

As a departmental graduate association (DGA) or consortium

- Your departmental association/consortium is governed by your internal constitution/bylaws. Ask your DGA exec where you can find these posted.
- · Your DGA is free to endorse/act in solidarity

As an individual or self-assembled collective

You are free to act so long as you remain in the <u>University's Policies and Procedures</u>.
