- A 2023-2026 strategic plan where highly engaged and thriving graduate students are used.
- The mission is to ensure that the needed services, communities, advocacy and growth opportunities are available to all UCalgary graduate students.
- Priorities envisaged is to address critical barriers by fighting for students, growing organisational capacities and strengthening organisational infrastructure to benefit UCalgary graduate student community.
- The organisational structure is made up of the GRC and the Board of Directors.
- With reporting and feedback, there is an annual report, an annual general meeting, GRC, annual survey and adhoc surveys.
- GRC dates given included October 31, November 28, January 30, February 27, March 26, April 30, and May 28.

GSA Executive Introductions – 5:25PM

President:

- Public representative of the association
- Oversees all governance and serves as the spokesperson of the association.
- Graduate student advocacy.
- Graduate student representative of the board of governors.

VP Academic:

- Student advocacy as well as overseeing awards committee for awards and bursaries.
- In charge of professional development opportunities and academic events
- Provides student support and leads academic workshops.

VP External:

- o Handles government relations, advocacy, and stakeholder relations.
- o Engages in advocacy with on-campus groups and research-based advocacy.
- Oversees food, housing, and security.
- o Oversees provincial advocacy and the national Indigenous advocacy committee.

VP Student Life:

- o In charge of student engagement.
- Advocacy includes EDI (Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion)
- o In charge of ensuring students are oriented and get discounted tickets.

VP Finance and Services:

- o Manages health and dental services, including student case tracking.
- o In charge of finance and the Finance Standing Committee.
- o Conducts monthly board financial reviews.
- o Responsible for committee creation.
- Manages sustainability initiatives through the sustainability committee.

GSA 2022-2023 Audited Financial Statements [Finance Standing Committee Chair]-5:39

- Communication and timely presentation of documentation to auditors
- The LDL incurred a loss of 45, 217 for March 31, 2023 and this was due to inflation, increasing cost of goods sold, unavoidable costs or amortisation, etc. This has had no impact on internal reserves.
